World’s Most Revolutionary Cruise Ship to Feature First Cupcake Shop at Sea

MIAMI, September 1, 2009 – When Royal Caribbean International’s *Oasis of the Seas* debuts in December 2009, the world’s largest and most revolutionary ship will offer the most diverse lineup of dining options and guest activities available industry wide. The cruise line is combining both of those experiences with yet another exciting addition to *Oasis of the Seas*’ breadth of offerings with the first cupcake shop at sea, aptly named The Cupcake Cupboard.

Harking back to the days of baking in grandmother’s kitchen, the 1940’s-style shop will offer a wide array of the beloved delicacies and emphasize memorable family experiences including decorating cupcakes in various creative designs.
